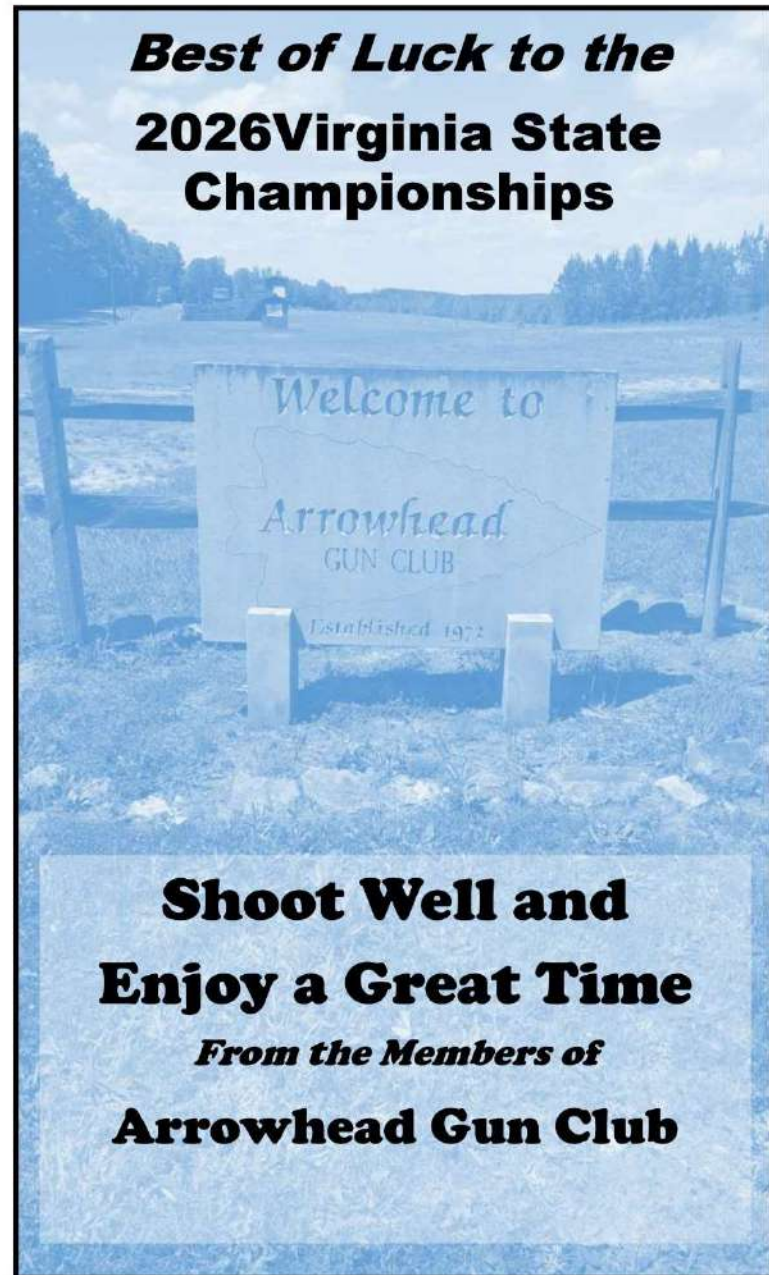

RULES AND SHOOT INFORMATION

The 2026 Virginia State Skeet Championships is a closed event open only to residents of the State of Virginia. Non-Virginia shooters may shoot TO, space available, at the same (subsidized) rate. Shooters MUST shoot the program sequence to be eligible for Gun and HOA awards (e.g., shooting events a day earlier than scheduled per the program will disqualify the shooter from HOA and that specific Gun event awards). It will NOT impact All-American points. The championships will be shot in accordance with current NSSA rules. Teams need not shoot shoulder to shoulder, except in shoot-offs. Management reserves the right to alter the program without recourse or protest, and reserves the right to refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any contestant who endangers, annoys, or interferes in any manner with the proper conduct of this tournament. Any changes deemed necessary will be posted in the registration area.

VSSA hopes that all participants and their families have a great experience at State. It is asked that children under the age of 12, for their own safety, must be under the supervision and responsibility of an adult at all times.

All score sheets must be checked and signed by a squad member prior to leaving the field. Scores will be posted as soon as possible after each flight has finished shooting. All shooters are responsible for verifying their posted scores and classes. No proofs will be provided.

Contestants and spectators assume all risks of loss or injury while on club grounds. All shotguns must be carried with the breech open, except when on the shooting station or in the gun rack. Safety demands this rule be adhered to while on club grounds and shooting fields. All participants, referees, and trap personnel must wear eye and ear protection. Eye protection is also recommended for spectators. Participants may NOT pick up spent shells from the fields after shooting is finished each day.

Flight times will be one hour and thirty minutes. Squads will not be announced; shooters should be at the scheduled field at least ten minutes prior to scheduled start time. Any shooter or squad not on the assigned field and ready to shoot when scheduled is subject to the possibility of not being able to shoot in that event. **Squads taking more than one hour and thirty minutes regardless of reasons may be moved to a practice field or a vacant field.** If no field is available, they will complete their rounds after all shooting is completed.

Protests: All protests will be processed in accordance with NSSA rules. Verbal protests to the Chief Referee must be made within thirty minutes of the protested incident. Written appeals of the Chief Referee's decision must be made to the Chairman of the Protest Committee within twelve hours of the incident; list of Protest Committee members on page 4.

Referee Responsibilities Referees will load the high house on the field they are working and remove the empty boxes from the houses. Squad members must load the low house. Targets will be adjusted only by the trap mechanics and the Chief/Assistant Chief Referee. The hoop will be used for all adjustments.

Shoot-offs: It is the shooter's responsibility to check the Scoreboard and posted shoot-offs. All scores or long-run ties for the Preliminary, Events 1-7 and All-American Concurrent event Champion, Runner-Up, and Third (and Events 1-7 Class 1st, 2nd and 3rd) will be shot off. Concurrent event ties will be shot off concurrently with Main Event shoot-offs when possible. Team

Champion only will be shot off. All other places (with the exception of Optional Purse ties) will be determined by longest long-run (long-run ties for any place will be called for a shoot-off). Shooters will furnish all shoot-off shells. All shoot-offs will be one round of doubles at stations 3, 4, and 5, miss and out by station. All subsequent rounds will be doubles at station 4, miss and out by station.

The HOA, HAA, and .410 events will be shot off with the .410. In team shoot-offs, team members will shoot shoulder to shoulder. A total team score will be determined by station. Gun malfunction and defective ammunition rules apply during shoot-offs.

ALL MONEY OPTION WINNINGS WILL BE MAILED.

AWARDS: Gun Championship awards (bowls, plaques & medals for CH/RU/3rd and buckles for Class 1st) will be awarded after shoot-offs. Class and concurrent awards (medals and plaques) will be available for pickup following the shoot-off for the event. Signs will be posted for when the awards' desk will be open. **Do not pickup any awards when no one is at the desk.** Please pick up your awards or make arrangements to have them picked up during posted hours. Only awards determined by the desk will be available for Sunday pickup—usually following the shoot-offs on Sunday. Awards not picked up or awarded by Sunday afternoon will be given to your club Director or his/her representative (club noted on your registration form) by the November meeting. If you won a perpetual trophy (bowl or plaque) in 2024, please bring it engraved and polished (or send it by a reliable courier) to this year's shoot.

Championship Belt Buckles: The VSSA awards a German silver belt buckle to each new Gun, HOA, & HAA Champion. Only one buckle is awarded to an individual. See the Shoot Management for information on getting your buckle or a stone added to signify additional championships. Buckles for state championships prior to 1991 (when this award began) may be purchased. (See page 45 for photo of buckle.)

Class Championship Belt Buckles: VSSA will award specially designed belt buckles for Class Champions in each gun, Doubles, and HOA.

Ammunition: Please make sure that you bring sufficient ammunition for all your events, shoot-offs, and proofs. Ammunition

Practice rounds are \$5.00. Practice fields open 8-4 will be available starting Thursday-Sunday. Pay for practice at clubhouse (Laura's desk not registration desk).

No pets are allowed in the clubhouse at any time. All pets must be on a leash and controlled at all times. Please clean up after your pets around the clubhouse, camping area, and skeet fields. Bring your pooper-scooper!

Food services will be available Thursday-Sunday 11am -2pm.

Friday Night Party will be hosted by VSSA. Following will be the General Membership meeting and then the Directors' meeting.

VSSA Hall of Fame Dinner hosted by Conservation Park will be held on Saturday night at no additional cost to the shooter and one guest. If additional dinner tickets are needed, they will be available for purchase at \$15. club (not registration desk).
